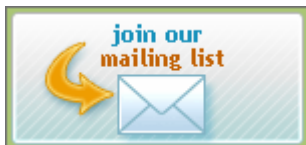

### **Grant Makes Church Census FREE to CBF Churches**

The Church Census is a powerful tool developed by the Baylor University School of Social Work. It is a standardized survey instrument that provides an in-depth profile of congregational family life. Beyond the U.S. census, the Church Census captures the strengths, challenges and stressors, and faith experiences of your church members. Participating churches will receive a comprehensive, computer-generated analysis, which can serve as a foundation for family ministry planning. Normally the Church Census costs five hundred dollars; however, through a recently secured grant, CBF churches can now receive this service at NO COST.
