### **C.E.R.T Training Available**

Mt. Zion Baptist Church in Macon has sensed a need it can fulfill in its community to be the presence of Christ during and after a disaster. Stan Braley, pastor, and Ken Bunch, church leader, have planned EMA C.E.R.T. training with Monroe County. It will be held two consecutive weekends, Friday evenings on August 3 and 10, and all day Saturdays on August 4 and 11.

C.E.R.T. is a nationally recognized training which that states, cities, and counties use to train willing community members to supplement depleted emergency response resources during a disaster event. C.E.R.T. stands for Community Emergency Response Team. Participants are trained in basic first aid, fire suppression, search, haz-mat awareness, incident command, and team work. Once trained, teams may be called upon by their county for assistance within the county or elsewhere. Skills learned are beneficial in all aspects of assisting neighbors near and far.

Mt. Zion Baptist Church invites other Macon-area churches to sign up to participate. Participation may lead to individuals going back to their congregations and planning to organize a team. If interested, you may contact Mt. Zion Baptist Church at 478-994-0838.
