From Georgia to Georgia



In keeping with our Georgia to Georgia Partnership, we are requesting your prayers for a young boy. His grandfather, Tengizi Kodelashvili, is a Baptist Pastor in the Republic of Georgia. Here is part of a note from the grandfather and a picture of Luka.

Luka Kodelashvili, a four year old boy, born in Georgia on November 19, 2004, became sick in autumn 2008. He had been operated on September 22, 2008, with purpose to take test to



reveal the right diagnosis and later the taken tests were sent in Germany, where the diagnose "Poorly differentiated Neuroblastoma-fourth grade tumor" had been confirmed by Institute for Pathologies UKSH-Campus Kiel, Germany. The main tumor was located in stomach and little ones were spread throughout the whole body.

Since then, Luka has been done six strong chemo-therapies during six months and afterwards has been sent to University Children's Hospital in Freiburg for operation in Germany, which had been done on April 6, 2009. The success of healing process depended on the test results taken after the operation. After returning back to Georgia, Luka will need four strong and thirteen months light chemo treatment course for the full recovery by Freiburg Hospital's recommendation. If the tumor doesn't grow more by that time, the whole treatment will be considered to be successful. But if not, Luka will again be taken to Germany. But as we've come so far and we rely on our Lord Savior, we believe that Luka will be cured wholly by his gracious mercy and might.
