Medical Team Trip to Haiti

Oakland Baptist Church, Rock Hill, SC, in cooperation with CBF Field Personnel, is putting together a medical team to travel to Grand Goave, Haiti, from Saturday-Saturday, January 7-January 14. The team will be housed in volunteer housing in Grand Goave and travel each day to nearby villages for clinics. Meals will be provided at the construction work site of Siloe. The team may be composed of health personnel, including physicians, nurses, dentists, and hygienists. Particularly desired is a dermatologist. Dentists and hygienists will need to bring basic equipment. No sites will have access to electricity. Bringing in a variety of medicines is also helpful. Cost is \$400 plus airfare to the capital city of Port au Prince. The cost takes care of onsite transportation, meals, and lodging.
