N.T. Wright will be at FBC Decatur on Tuesday, November 8, at 7:00 p.m. to lecture and sign his new book, *Simply Jesus: Who He Was, What He Did, Why It Matters*. Wright, the Bishop of Durham, former canon theologian of Westminster Abbey and dean of Litchfield Cathedral, is a renowned New Testament scholar who has written more than a dozen acclaimed books, including *Simply Christian*.
