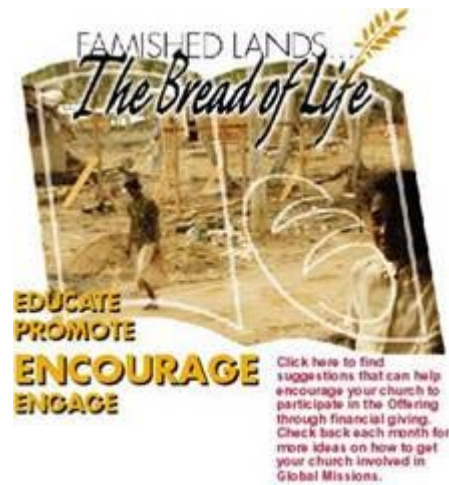

CBF-endorsed chaplains meet needs of hurricane residents, relief workers

ATLANTA – As the Gulf Coast continues to recover from hurricanes Katrina and Rita, Cooperative Baptist Fellowship endorsed chaplains are working to meet the emotional and spiritual needs of residents and relief workers.

“CBF chaplains and pastoral counselors have been a presence of Christ with evacuees,” said George Pickle, CBF associate coordinator for chaplaincy and pastoral counsel. “Evacuees have experienced overwhelming grief in the deaths of loved ones, loss of home, community, work, money, material possessions and psychological stability. Chaplains and pastoral counselors have been a vital and essential care presence with evacuees in their journey of grief. We are grateful for their ministry with people in the devastation of the hurricanes.”



Jack Brown

Jack Brown, a CBF-endorsed chaplain for the Carl Vinson Veterans Affairs Medical Center in Dublin, Ga., spent weeks in Texas working with evacuees from Hurricane Rita. Brown volunteered through the Department of Veterans Affairs, which is operating shelters in Waco and Marlin, Texas – the federal shelters even operated by the VA. Brown was one of the

chaplains working at the federal shelter in Marlin. The shelter, which was formerly a VA medical center, housed approximately 150 evacuees – mainly residents of Beaumont and Port Arthur. Brown provided pastoral care to the residents and staff, leading Sunday chapel services and devotions, arranging for a Catholic priest to conduct Mass and visiting with residents and doing informal counseling.

“One woman said that the shelter was like a bridge over troubled water,” Brown recalled. “I thought the shelter as a bridge was really an appropriate metaphor. That’s what we were trying to be – a safe place, a bridge of safety. Our desire was to hold them until they had a place to go that would be safe.”

Brown, who has participated in disaster preparedness

training with the VA and Red Cross, was also involved in other aspects of the shelter. Along with his fellow chaplain they arranged recreation and transportation needs, as we organized donations.
