

All nominations should be received in writing by March 15. Nominees will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- Demonstrates faithful commitment to the development of her ministry
- Exhibits the characteristics of a mentor of women in ministry;
- Exemplifies qualities of gifted leadership and redemptive service;
- Maintains an active role in the ministry of her local church; and
- Displays support for the goals and visions of BWIMGA.
