## Executive Coordinator Search Committee Nominations Sought - Deadline Is May 1!

In light of Executive Coordinator Frank Broome's announcement of his decision to retire effective December 31, 2017, the Nominating Committee of the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship of Georgia (CBF/GA) calls for nominations of persons to serve on the Search Committee for our next Executive Coordinator. From the nominees, the Nominating Committee will select four (4) individuals to serve. Upon the approval of the CBF/GA's Coordinating Council on May 23, 2017, the four people nominated will join Moderator Julie Long, Moderator-Elect Keithen Tucker, and Past Moderator Henry Tyson to form the Search Committee, as stipulated in the CBF/GA's Constitution and Bylaws.
