College Student Mission Trip to NYC Planned for March 5 - 12, 2022!

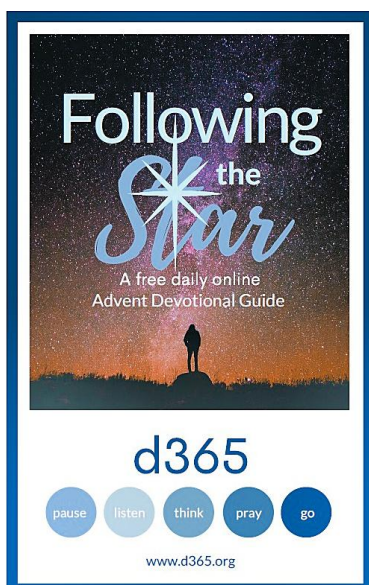
- Deposit \$50 each; total cost is \$300 per student
